- Renaissance (1450-1600) means "rebirth". Great artistic advances = "humanism" = art, philosophy, literature, centered on man rather than God; live and accomplishments on earth rather than heaven or hell
- Influences:
 - rediscovery of Greek and Roman sculpture with proportions accurately reproduced
 - ancient literature and philosophy (Plato and Aristotle) = Greek tragedies and poems portraying man's struggle against a fate ordained by destiny = Renaissance art
 - harmony and balance = artists rearrange landscapes to make nature suit their ideals
 - architecture = domes rather than Gothic spires
- Renaissance music different from Middle Ages in one important way =
 overall sound smoother and more blended; change was because of changes
 in composition techniques; independent lines of Middle Ages polyphony
 replaced by new style based on <u>imitation</u> = parts overlap (round)
- Early Renaissance = merging of individual European areas into one international style of music
